Submission Information

- Eligibility: To be eligible, the abstract must be submitted by a trainee (student, resident, or fellow)
- Trainees who are not active members of the Distinguished Nigerian Physicians of Tomorrow (DNPT) will need an ANPA member sponsor to verify their Nigerian affiliation (i.e. trainee must be of Nigerian heritage, naturalized citizen of Nigeria, spouse of a Nigerian, or otherwise demonstrate a Nigerian affinity acceptable to the program committee). The ANPA sponsor must a member in good standing (i.e., up to date with their dues). The ANPA sponsor is not required to be a co-author on the abstract.
- If a DNPT member, verification from the DNPT president is required.
- Abstract Notification: The winner will be notified via email on before February 15, 2022.

What type of studies?

The abstract may address basic science, a clinical condition, programmatic challenges, or quality improvement (QI) efforts geared specifically towards *improving health and clinical outcomes*. Abstracts may focus on any aspect of the continuum of care, including but not limited to patient care, provider/nursing/pharmacy practice/management/education/QI/program development and case reports.

Guidelines to Format Your Abstract

ABSTRACT TITLE (14 font size, uppercase, bold, Times New Roman)

Author's Names (12 font size, Times New Roman, underscore presenting author)

Affiliations (12 font size, italic, Times New Roman)

Body (12 font size, Times New Roman, not to exceed 300 words)

- May include no more than 1 figure or table
- Abstract must be structured (see below)
- Editing of abstracts post submission will not be permitted
- Use Microsoft Word only.

The Structure of Your Abstract

- **Background/Significance**: What was the problem and why was it important? What knowledge are you building on?
- **Method:** What was the design? What was the sample? What instruments were used? How was data collected and analyzed? What was the evidence-based solution? How was it developed and implemented? Cite the research for the evidence implying how you made a clinical decision based on the best available current research or literature, your own clinical expertise, or patient's needs to change a process to improve practice. Do not submit an actual reference/bibliography list.
- **Results:** What were the findings? What were the outcomes of the project? How was success measured?
- Conclusions: What do the findings mean? How can this be applied more globally?
